The examinations are scored on the French rating system ("0" to "20", with "20" being the best and "10" being the minimum score to validate a course).

Training in a Joint Research Unit and Internship at Montpellier SupAgro

Period

Internships can begin at any time of the year. Internship may last from 2 to 6 months. Internships of more than two months are remunerated but more difficult to obtain.

Language requirements

Proficiency is required in French or in English. In some cases, other languages can be accepted.

Nomination and Application Procedures

Requirements	Official evidence student have completed at least 4 semesters of graduate studies (120 ECTS) for the tracks given at Florac Campus (B.Sc. 3 level) and 6 semesters (180 ECTS) for the other tracks B1/B2 level in French and/or English, depending on the selected track
Nomination and Application	Students should be nominated by their home institution. Nominated students will receive an email with their login and password. Application form and documents must be completed/uploaded ONLINE : ID-photo, ID-document, Transcript of records of higher education, Language certificates in French and/or English (depending on courses), Cover letter and Application file.
Deadlines for Application	Full year or Autumn semester: 15th April Spring semester: 15th October
